How we use cookies and similar technologies on the Service.

This Cookie Policy explains how Music Co LLC ("Music Coast," "we," "us") uses cookies and similar technologies on musiccoast.com, our web applications, and in certain app contexts (collectively, the "Service").

This Policy should be read together with our Privacy Policy.

1. What Are Cookies?

Cookies are small text files placed on your device when you visit a website. Similar technologies include pixels, local storage, SDKs, and device identifiers. These tools help websites and apps remember preferences, improve functionality, measure performance, and (in some cases) deliver advertising.

2. Types of Cookies and Technologies We May Use

Depending on how you use the Service, we may use:

- Strictly necessary cookies/technologies for security, authentication, load balancing, and core site/app features.
- Functional cookies to remember preferences (for example, language or settings).
- Analytics cookies/technologies to understand how the Service is used and to improve performance.
- Advertising cookies/technologies to deliver and measure ads, including interest-based ads where permitted by law.

3. Third-Party Services (Including Advertising)

We may use third-party services to operate the Service, measure traffic, and deliver ads. For example, if we display ads, third-party advertising partners (such as Google) may use

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cookies or similar technologies to collect information about your activity on the Service and across other sites or apps to provide and measure ads.

Third-party providers may act as independent controllers of the data they collect. Their use of information is governed by their own privacy policies.

4. Your Choices

You can control cookies and similar technologies in several ways:

- Cookie banner/consent tools: Where required by law, we will present cookie consent choices and allow you to change your preferences.
- Browser settings: Many browsers let you delete or block cookies. If you block cookies, some features of the Service may not work properly.
- Mobile settings: Your device may allow you to limit ad tracking or reset your advertising identifier.
- Ad choices tools: Some advertising providers offer tools to control interest-based ads (for example, Google ad settings).

Note: If you use multiple devices or browsers, you may need to apply your preferences on each one.

5. Do Not Track

Some browsers send "Do Not Track" signals. Because there is no consistent industry standard for interpreting these signals, we do not respond to them in a uniform way.
